

RUBBER STAMP REPS

Punishing Cities with Community Trust Policies

Dozens of House members represent districts where the majority of the constituents voted against this administration's platform, yet these representatives are acting as rubber stamps for the White House's extreme agenda rather than working for the people they represent.

Issue Background

The below Representatives voted for HR 3003—an anti-immigrant bill designed to punish cities with community trust policies in place in order to boost the administration's indiscriminate mass deportation plans. This bill gives more unchecked federal authority to apprehend, detain, and deport immigrants that are our neighbors. Stripping resources from local law enforcement in an attempt to defund sanctuary cities endangers public safety and diminishes the critical bonds of trust between law enforcement and community members. It also encourages racial profiling and deters victims or witnesses of crimes from coming forward out of fear of being referred to U.S. Immigration and Customs Enforcement. The bill also violates the rights of migrants by allowing detention without probable cause, without judicial approval, and without basic due process protections.

Members of Congress should oppose this bill because it violates the rights of vulnerable migrants, endangers public safety, and damages critical bonds of trust between local authorities and the community.
